The doctoral school of chemistry in Lyon is one of the most prominent in France with **8 research units** in which about **200 PhD supervisors** are repartited.

The doctoral school belong to Université de Lyon (<http://www.universite-lyon.fr/>) and is member of a national network of **20 doctoral schools** of chemistry in France (www.docteurs-chimie.org).

An average of **80 PhD** are defended in Lyon each year covering researches in the specific fields of chemistry as **synthesis of bio-active molecules, analytical sciences, catalysis, processes, applied to polymers, materials, oil industry, depollution and environmental sciences.**

Some specific new Institutes belong to the doctoral school as the new Institute for Analytical Sciences and the European Center for Very High Field NMR that received recently **the first 1GHz 1H NMR system in the world.**
